Novice Riders

For new or younger riders, who require assistance grooming & tacking their horse.

Beginner Group Lessons w/Horsemanship (2 to 4 riders) For those who require assistance tacking/grooming. Includes 15 min horsemanship, plus 45 minutes of riding.	\$ 65
Beginner Private Lessons (individual) For those who require assistance tacking/grooming. Includes 15 min horsemanship, plus 30 minutes of riding.	\$ 80
Helmet Rental (per lesson)	\$ 5
Introduction to Riding (1 to 3 riders) Two x 1-hour lessons for beginners. Or use as a refresher! See website for more details. Gift Certificates available.	\$ 130

Friendly Barn Reminders to Students and Parents!

Before Lesson

Please arrive 20-30 minutes before your scheduled lesson to properly groom and tack your assigned horse.

Students are not permitted to begin their class with any horse covered in dirt, unpicked feet, or shavings in the tail. Ensure you arrive with enough time to complete grooming, because the instructor and class will not be able to wait.

After Lesson

Properly cool down your horse!

Fully groom your horse and pick their feet after every lesson.

Horses tacked in a stall must be tied on a short lead that is provided inside.

All tack must be sponge cleaned with saddle soap at the sink.

Bits must be cleaned thoroughly, and rinsed with water.

Put all your brushes and tack away neatly.

Ensure aisle is swept and tidy, and stall doors properly shut and latched.

Be sure your horse has plenty of water!

Visitors

Visitors are welcome, but please inform them not to approach, touch, or feed the horses without an instructor present. Visiting children must have adult supervision at all times.

Parents and visitors are not allowed in the arena or riding ring during a lesson.

Visitors should be wearing closed shoes (not sandals) to enter barn.

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the property.

WRA Lesson Policies

WRA Lesson Bookings

Simply email us with dates and times you have available, and we will reply with options available in our schedule. Fall and spring are especially busy, so please book early to avoid disappointment. For ongoing lesson programs, we re-book times at the beginning of each season.

Preference is given to those taking ongoing weekly lessons, and we ask all riders to confirm their riding schedule by the 1st of each month. Also notify us early with any dates you plan to be away.

Changing or Cancelling Your Lesson

If you cannot show up for your booked lesson time, we are happy to re-schedule. We do appreciate as much notice as possible but require a minimum of 48 hours notice to cancel. This allows us to fill your reserved spot and assign the instructor and horse to another student wishing to ride.

Unexpected illness & emergency cancellations are limited to once per year without charge. After the first lesson is missed without adequate notice (*less than 48 hrs notice*), riders will be charged \$25 per missed lesson.

Any changes to your lesson schedule must be done in writing by email. Please do not leave information on the phone, or with the instructor. Any lesson missed without written notice by email will not be refunded or re-scheduled.

In the case of severe inclement weather, we do cancel and re-schedule lessons for another date.

Lesson Size

Riding fees are based on the actual size of the lesson that occurs. Despite our best efforts, rider cancellations due to illness and emergencies are frequent and make it impossible to guarantee lesson sizes. If you do not wish to ride in a lesson where the number of riders may fluctuate, we suggest you consider half-hour or full private lessons.

Lesson Payment

Lesson payments are due at the beginning of every month with your booking. Credit cards & E-transfers are preferred. Envelopes are available at the red payment box in middle aisle of the barn. Please let us know your method of payment.

WRA Rider Rewards

Rider Rewards are for individuals and families who take multiple lessons, and are credited toward future lessons at the end of each quarter. A chart of rewards is listed with our lesson fees.
